



Ford Upfitter Interface Module (UIM) – Read Me First

This UIM web site has been provided to support fleet and upfitter communities with information about the Ford Upfitter Interface Module (UIM). You must read and accept the Terms and Conditions posted on this page to gain access to the programming software. Once accepted, the UIM software download links will become active during your current session. If you close your session you will need to open the Terms and Conditions and accept once again.

There are several documents provided to help you understand the Upfitter Interface Module base function and program needs. Since the UIM comes from the factory “blank”, it is up to you to develop a strategy and logic for use in the UIM.

TO DOWNLOAD ALL REQUIRED FILES:

STEP 1: Open, review and accept the ***Terms and Conditions***

STEP 2: ***Download all files*** to your PC by clicking each link and selecting download. Always use “Save As” versus “Open”. Be sure to save the files to a location you can later find (desktop is suggested).

STEP 3: Once downloaded, from your PC, double click the ***Project Editor*** file. You will be prompted to install. Choose all default locations and naming conventions offered by the installer.

STEP 4: Once downloaded, from your PC, double click the ***Project Editor Document*** file. You will be prompted to install. Choose all default locations and naming conventions offered by the installer.

STEP 5: ***Review all PDF documents*** before attempting to program the UIM.

IMPORTANT! AFTER YOU CREATE A UIM CONFIGURATION USING THE FORD PROVIDED UIM EDITOR, AND HAVE SUCCESSFULLY FLASHED (PROGRAMMED) THE UIM AND VALIDATED VEHICLE OPERATION, BE SURE TO NAME AND SAVE THE UIM CONFIGURATION FILE USING THE VEHICLE VIN NUMBER.
